Why do you want to be a member of the Public Art Advisory Committee?

I live in Brisbane and I am raising two young kids here, so how this town looks and feels matters to me daily. We walk the new staircase to and from Star City Montessori every morning, and watching my kids stop to admire it has shown me exactly what good public art does in a small city. I want to give back to the place that has become our home, and the honest reason is simple: I want more beauty around my kids as they grow up here. I am a designer by trade, and I would like to put that toward where I live, not just where I work, helping the committee turn its current projects into things people actually live with.

I am a designer with a PhD in human-computer interaction, and I lead design for a health and life sciences group at AWS. The relevant part is the practice: I evaluate creative work against clear criteria and run selection processes where you have to pick one direction and defend it in the open.
I am also a hands-on builder. I did a permitted rebuild of our Brisbane home. That work taught me what survives outdoors on the bay, which is directly relevant to benches, stairways, and the restoration work this committee takes on.
On community, the most honest answer is that my family is rooted here. I am raising two kids in Brisbane and we are part of the daily life of the town. I want them growing up somewhere that takes pride in how it looks, and this committee is where I want to put that in.

What do you feel you could contribute to the Public Art Advisory Committee? Please provide information that demonstrates your interest in Public Art.

Three things. Design judgment: I can help read proposals against the committee's mission and give artists specific, useful feedback on siting, scale, and sightlines. A builder's eye for what lasts: most of Brisbane's public art lives outdoors, and I know materials, fabrication, and maintenance well enough to help choose work that endures and budget honestly for keeping it that way. And process: I have run selection processes for years and can help keep ours fair, clear, and moving.
My interest comes from being a designer and a parent, not an

art historian, which I think is the useful angle. Most people never set foot in a gallery. They meet art on a staircase or a bench, the exact things this committee commissions. I meet it that way myself every morning on the walk to school. That ground-level layer is what I care about most, and Brisbane already has a feel for it. I would like to help sharpen it.
