# Complete Streets Safety Committee

## 2025 Work Plan

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1. Finalize investigation of potential for one-way streets - Mariposa and Monterey between Visitacion and Solano. (referred by Director of Public Works)
2. Review and recommend improvements to address speeding and overall traffic safety issues on Visitacion Ave. incorporating community feedback (due 90 days from 4/2/25 committee meeting)
3. Receive and comment on Baylands transportation circulation plans or other proposals referred by Director of Public Works or City Manager
4. Speeding, traffic calming measures, and general traffic issues on San Bruno Ave. in response to prior community concerns
5. Review feedback on Pilot Parking Program on Thomas Ave. before staff brings to Council

## Complete Streets Safety Committee 2026 Work Plan Ideas

### High-level items proposed by the CSSC

- Conduct a city-wide sidewalk audit assessing whether there are sidewalks in certain areas, are the sidewalks in disarray, are there crosswalks needing improvement, and are there visibility issues (trees/shrubs/cars)
- Conduct a commercial traffic audit which includes studying the traffic flow of commercial trucks
- Discuss improvements to lighting of sidewalks. Review the decline of streetlights and the hazards of walking the sidewalks in Brisbane. Width of sidewalk issues, cars parked on sidewalks, and imperfections in the sidewalks that need repair
- Discuss removal of median at Park Lane to afford commercial trucks a better turning radius to exit town in the commercial area, add loading zone striping and signage where needed
- Conduct bicycle audit which includes visibility issues, improvement to Tunnel Ave/Lagoon Road, bicycle flow through town

### Items to consider proposed by the CSSC

- Improved signage throughout city for pedestrians, bicyclists and vehicular traffic
- Improved signage of alleyways and identification on map
- Tree and bush maintenance along sidewalks and streets
- Retaining wall at Glen Park and San Bruno for BES to protect against vehicles
- General clean-up of striping and refresh of signage city wide
- Installation of traffic light at Bayshore and San Bruno
- Process for Grant applications to get funding for projects outside of annual budget
- Parking discussion regarding parking city wide and cars parking on sidewalks
- Service request response time
